Custodian Position

ISD 100 Wrenshall School has an opening for a 1.0 FTE Custodian.

Principal Responsibilities: The custodian must provide general cleaning. This position ensures a clean and safe work and school environment by ensuring that rooms, hallways, bathrooms and stairwells are kept clean/sanitized and safe for our staff and students. This position often requires custodians to be alone in the building during early morning hours or later in the day hours. There is also a high degree of attention needed with detail and trust.

- Sweep and mop classroom floors.
- Clean and sanitize desktops and tables.
- Put all chairs back on the floor after each room has been cleaned.
- Empty garbage and replace bags in classrooms.
- Wash black or white boards in classrooms.
- Clean bathrooms and/or locker rooms; fill paper towel and toilet paper dispensers; clean bathrooms with cleaning machine and scrub floor; disinfect water fountains, sinks, toilets, and urinals using our color-coded cleaning system.
- Vacuum rugs in classrooms.
- Sweep stairwells.
- Clean windows in the lobby area.
- All trash from these areas must be taken out every day.
- Machine clean hallways.
- Other duties may be assigned.

Work conditions include standing, walking, stairs, heavy lifting, pulling, pushing, etc. May be required to come in early for snow removal.

This position reports to the Facilities Manager.

Salary: This is an AFSCME Union, Grade 4, year-round position starting at \$17.20/hour.
